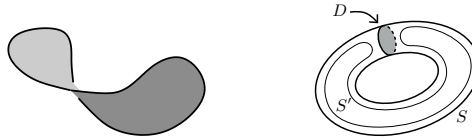


## Welcome to Regina!

Did you know that you can embed PDF documents directly inside your Regina data files? This means that you can annotate your data with diagrams:



and also with equations:

$$\dots \longrightarrow H_n(A \cap B) \xrightarrow{\Phi} H_n(A) \oplus H_n(B) \xrightarrow{\Psi} H_n(X) \xrightarrow{\partial} H_{n-1}(A \cap B) \longrightarrow \dots$$

Simply write a document using your favourite word processor or typesetting system (such as  $\text{\LaTeX}$ ), convert it to PDF format, and import your PDF into Regina by selecting *New PDF Document* from the *Packet Tree* menu.

Regina will display your document using an external viewer, such as *evince* or *okular* under Linux, or *Preview* on a Mac. You can choose a different viewer by editing the PDF settings in Regina's preferences.
